


International Teaching Week 2026, 13. 4. 2026 - 17. 4. 2026



Participation Fees

1. Participation Fee for International Teaching Week 2026: 70 EUR

The participation fee covers all programme-related cultural and social activities, including:

- Morning coffee on all teaching days held at GEA College
- Boat ride along the Ljubljanica River, an iconic way to explore Ljubljana's old town from the water
- Guided tour of Center Rog, Ljubljana's Creative Hub
- Guided tour of Pivovarna Union, one of Slovenia's most recognisable and historically significant breweries. Founded in 1864, Union is a cultural symbol of Slovenian brewing tradition and an important part of the country's industrial heritage.
- Dinner at Union Brewery Pub, including a drink, starter, and main course.

This fee is mandatory for all participants of International Teaching Week.

2. ABSRC Conference Participation Fees

Participants who wish to join the ABSRC International Scientific Conference running in parallel to the Teaching Week may choose between the following options:

- 50 EUR – *Listener Fee*
Includes attendance at the full conference programme.
- 100 EUR – *Presenter Fee*
Includes paper presentation, participation in the scientific programme, and conference materials.

3. Publication in the ABSRC Monograph

Authors whose conference papers are selected for publication in the official ABSRC monograph will be notified after the review process. A separate publication fee applies and will be communicated individually to the selected authors.
